As co-chairs of the Amicus-Judiciary Committee, we are committed to placing more LGBTQI (and LGBTQI friendly) judges to the bench and making sure our voices are heard when it comes to legal and policy decisions that impact our communities. This year, we helped to review BALIF member applications for open judicial positions, made recommendations to the Governor's office on appointments and vetted and endorsed the following judicial candidates for the March 3 elections in Alameda and San Francisco: Mark Fickes, Elena Condes, Maria Evangelista, Rani Singh, Michelle Tong and Carolyn Gold. We hope to hear from our membership on how we can continue to support them their efforts in becoming judges.

We continue to work with our partners to protect and advance LGBTQI rights. As the Amicus Committee, BALIF signed on to several amicus briefs to support and advance LGBT rights, including but not limited to R.G. & G.R. Harris Funeral Homes v. EEOC, consolidated cases about whether the existing federal ban on sex discrimination forbids employment discrimination against LGBTQ workers; June Medical Service v. Gee, a major abortion-rights case in the U.S. Supreme Court; Baltimore v. Azar, a lawsuit challenging HHS's denial of care regulation, and challenges to the Trump administrations Title X domestic gag rule. We will continue to actively monitor the outcomes of cases that impact our communities and invite BALIF members to suggest our amici intervention in cases that could benefit from our involvement.

Conference of California Bar Associations Committee

BALIF's CCBA committee lobbies for legislative change on issues that affect the LGBTQI community:

This year, BALIF's CCBA committee worked on the following resolutions, which were approved at the Conference.

- 1. Change Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples Day
- 2. Ban of oxybenzone and octinoxate in sunscreen
- 3. Making election day a paid holiday in California;
- 4. An extension of the statute of limitations for all claimants of death and personal injury tort claims against government entities to one year to file the government tort claim (from the currency 6 months) and a full 2 years from rejection notice to file a civil suit in state court. (Re: incarcerated individuals)

The following resolutions were either disapproved by the conference or withdrawn for resubmission:

- 1. Homeless Bill of Rights (5 votes short)
- Affirmative defense of consent for assault and battery. See BDSM community (4 votes short)
- 3. Decriminalization of sexwork (withdrawn)

CCBA also voted to approve and argued in favor of the following resolutions:

- 1. gender-neutral language in the Evidence Code;
- adding transgender as a protected status under the Fair Employment & Housing Act;
- equiring hospitals to provide patients with the estimated cost of anticipated services; and

- allowing transgender employees access to workplace lactation/wellness rooms for post-surgical care;
- 5. ban of plastic bags for newspapers

She is a founder and the Executive Director of the Compton's Transgender Cultural District – the world's first transgender district, celebrating the resilience, culture, and presence of transgender people in San Francisco's famed Tenderloin neighborhood. She is also the founder of Kween Culture Initiative – a social and cultural empowerment project for Black transgender women.

In addition to her efforts in community development, Ms. Sa'id has written and/or led numerous public policy efforts both in the City and County of San Francisco and at the California state legislature; most notably co-creating the United States' first sex worker protection law, *Prioritizing Safety for Sex Workers (San Francisco)*, and The Name and Dignity Act for Incarcerated Transgender People (Atkins- California). She has also supported legislation, such as SCR 110 (California) the first legislation in U.S. history to name the harms of nonconsensual medical interventions on intersex people. She has also led and/or provided strategy to San Francisco legislation supporting cultural districts,



access to gender neutral restrooms, and transgender latina violence prevention – and political strategy support to California state legislature policies that reduce barriers for transgender and non-binary individuals seeking affirming gender markers on state issued documents.

Ms. Sa'id is the former appointed LGBT Policy Advisor to the San Francisco Human Rights Commission, a municipal agency of the City and County of San Francisco. She is a 2016–2017 Policy Fellow alum of the Women's Foundation of California, and 2016–2017 Sojourner Truth Leadership Fellow of the Auburn Theological Seminary in New York.
